G – Gather for Prayer

Father,

I praise you for your matchless glory! You are the Creator of all and worthy of praise! Remind me that you are over and above all that I see and always in control.

R – Read the Text (Genesis 1:1-5)

“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 The earth was formless and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was moving over the surface of the waters. Then God said, “Let there be light”; and there was light. God saw that the light was good; and God separated the light from the darkness. God called the light day, and the darkness He called night. And there was evening and there was morning, one day.”

O – Observe what God has said

What do we learn about God in these verses?

How is this passage different than what the world teaches about the origins of the world?

W – Work on Application

What is introduced in this passage is antithetical to what the world teaches about the world's origins. So many of the FOLKS around us have been brought up with a worldview bereft of the truth that is revealed in these verses here—truth that we need to speak in love to those around us.

How might we seek to communicate to our “one” or to others around us that they were created?
