G – Gather for Prayer

R – Read the Text (Acts 1:6-8)

“So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, “Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?” He said to them, “It is not for you to know times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority; but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth.”

W – Work on Application

If you are a follower of Jesus already, perhaps, right now, you need to be reminded (dear believer) of why the Spirit has indwelt you. He has not taken up residence in your life to be a forgotten tenant that doesn't really impact your life. He has taken up residence in your life and in my life as a disrupter of the status quo, an invader of our space, and a driver that would have us go and bear witness of what Jesus Christ has done for us wherever and whenever He may lead. The time is now, the stakes are high, but the Spirit has been given and the salvation people around us need is available. Will you and will I testify to such?
